

## The institution assesses the learning levels of the students and organises special Programmes for advanced learners and slow learners

All the students in a class differ in their learning abilities, such as grasping power, applying the learned concepts to solve real-world problems etc. Our institution has made some policies to identify advanced learners and slow learners. Hence, college organizes orientation program for the parents and the students at the commencement of the programme for the new batch every year. The program would help students and parents get familiarized with the institution, curricular and co-curricular activities, facilities, rules and regulations etc. Before the commencement of the classes, the different requirements of the students are identified and addressed at the earliest by way of a strategic approach.

Every year students are given a training on communication skills, personality development, time management and motivational sessions. In order to motivate both the slow and quick learners workshops are organized to enhance their skills. Skill development activities are arrange workshops with hands-on session to improve students programming skills. With the active participation of advanced learners as coordinators both set of students get benefited.

The institution assesses the learning levels of the students in two ways at the time of the commencement of the programme. Students enrolled in various disciplines are identified as slow and advanced learners based on their PUC marks and the entry level test conducted by each department. This helps to identify the slow learners and to design special coaching sessions or tutorial sessions to bridge the gap between the slow learners and the advanced learners. The faculty members of UG and PG extend valid support to the students based on observation and class tests.

**Strategies adopted for slow learners:** Remedial Classes are conducted with an aim to improve the academic performance of the slow learners, absentees and students who participate in sports and other activities. Group Study System is also encouraged with the help of the advanced learners.

**Strategies for the advanced learners:** Special Coaching is also given in Skill Development Programme like Communicative English, Aptitude and Placement. Advanced Learners are provided coaching classes for competitive exams. Talented students are motivated to participate in extra-curricular activities, exhibitions and cultural competitions.
